

Lice Policy

Due to the high transference rate of lice and in order to limit those affected, a student will be sent home if there are any nits or lice found in their hair. If the presence of lice on a student is confirmed or suspected, Channing Hall reserves the right to discretely check the student's hair for evidence of lice. Parents may choose not to have their child's hair checked at school but must provide a medical check-up to confirm that there is no evidence of infection. Proof of using lice shampoo and a check of the student's hair are required prior to the student returning to school. Channing Hall strongly suggests the use of a lice comb when delousing a student.

Notification:

- Classrooms with more than one confirmed case of head lice within a two week period may email or send home lice information to parents.
- Channing Hal may notify parents that confirmed cases of head lice have been reported at the school or in the community.
